

There are many capital projects proposed, planned and underway in Saint Paul's **East Side River District** (ESRD) – the area bound by the Mississippi River on the west and south and the bluffs to the north and east. The Great River Passage Conservancy and City of Saint Paul regularly convenes public land owners, jurisdictional bodies and institutions to share presentations on their capital project(s), plans, or updates.

The goal—to share updates, discuss implementation strategy, challenges and opportunities, all to be aware of and support one another's work, identify potential partnerships and *Reveal*, *Heal*, *Connect and Protect* this critical and vibrant stretch of river.

In 2017 St. Paul's Great River Passage hosted an initial gathering of East Side River District leaders around the notion that *the whole is greater than the sum of the parts*. This is the ongoing approach—to provide an opportunity for all organizations to know what each other is planning and be able to coordinate efforts so opportunities are not missed.
